2. Applicants belonging to Tamil Nadu only will be considered for admission. However the following categories of candidates are also eligible to apply. Children of central Government employees and children of persons employed in Registered Joint Stock Companies, Private or Public or Government Recognized Institutions not domiciled in this State may also apply and compete with other candidates for admission irrespective of their domicile provided

## 6. Selection will be made under the following categories:

1. Open Competition
2. Backward Class (others)
3. Backward Class (Muslim)
4. Most Backward Class / Denotified Communities
5. Scheduled Caste
6. Scheduled Caste Arunthathiyar
7. Scheduled Tribe

The percentage of seats under the above categories will be as per the orders of Government of Tamil Nadu. **Any Reservation Policy changed by TN Government will also applicable.**

### Note:

1. A member of the Scheduled Caste on conversion to Christianity will be consideration only under Backward Class and not under Scheduled Caste.
2. No person who professes a religion different from the Hinduism or Sikh religion shall be deemed to be a member of a schedule caste.
3. A member of scheduled tribe will however continue to be treated as a member, irrespective whether he is a convert to any religion or he is descended from such a convert.
4. A candidate who claims to belong to scheduled caste by virtue of re-conversion should give all and full details regarding date of re-conversion and whether the candidate on such re-conversion is accepted by members of the particular community of the locality where he/she resides as belonging to

the particular community which he claims to belong. Re-conversion from Christianity to Hinduism will be considered only if notified in the Gazette before 1st July of the year of admission.

5. Candidates are warned that if the community certificates are not issued / signed by the competent authority / they will not be considered as belonging to ST/SC/SCA/MBC & DNC/BC/BCM as the case may be. They will be in that case considered only under "Others" and privilege that have been given, on the presumption that the candidate belongs to ST/ SC/ SCA/ MBC & DNC/ BC/ BCM as per the details given under the Item No.8 (b) of the application form will be withdrawn. The selection made already on the basis of community privilege will be cancelled and they have to compete for a seat under Open Competition along with other. If they are not qualified to be considered under "Other" their application will be treated as rejected.

## 6. The selection of ST/SCA/SC/MBC & DNC/BC

**BCM** candidates under open competition is in addition to the reservation made for them.

Permanent community certificate of ST should be issued only by the R.D.O. of their native place or Collector of their districts or PA (General) to Collector of Chennai.

**Permanent Community certificate alone be Valid.** The community certificate is valid only after obtaining State Gopuram Seal.

## 7 MODE OF SELECTION

**(HSC and 10<sup>th</sup> Std. +2 years ITI)**

Selection of candidates shall be done by ranking of all candidates put together (Irrespective of the branch of study). The candidates are selected on the basics of total marks secured in the +2

Examinations. (i.e. out of 1200).10<sup>th</sup> Std. passed + 2 years I.T.I are selected on the basis of Total Marks secured is the Qualifying Examinations, up to a maximum of 20% sanctioned intake

### **8. GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. Fees, Scholarships, Education loans, Hostel Facilities etc., Information can be had from the Principal of IRT Polytechnic College.

2. The following original certificates should be produced at the time of admission or when required by the principal.

- (i) Conduct certificate & Transfer Certificate in original obtained from the head of the Education Institute in which the candidate has last studied.
- (ii) SSLC Book or equivalent.
- (iii) HSC / ITI mark sheet or mark sheet issued by the concerned educational authority for the qualifying examination **with school seal on the backside of the mark sheet.**
- (iv) Original community certificates along with a Xerox of community certificates duly attested.

### **OTHER IMPORTANT POINTS**

1. Application received after the prescribed date and applications which are not in proper form or which are not correctly filled in or not received on or before the due date and application which do not fulfill the terms of the "instruction to candidates " will be considered defective and are liable for rejection.

2. The Application number should be quoted in all correspondences connected with the application and admission.

**3. Branches will be allotted according to merit through counseling by the principal as per communal reservation.**
